India plans expansion of Iran's Chabahar Port, mulls linking it with INSTC: Report

NEW DELHI: Chabahar port had handled 123 vessels and 1.8 million tonnes of bulk and general cargoes from February 2019 to January 2021, India's Shipping Minister Mansukh Mandaviya said in March.

India is planning to expand Iran's Chabahar port by supplying two more cranes.

India is also planning to link the strategically located port with the International North-South Transport Corridor

(INSTC) to boost trade with Russia and Eurasia. New consignments might be traded through the INSTC in near future, the report said.

India is mulling supplying two mobile harbour cranes for the Chabahar port by the middle of 2021 to deal with the increasing traffic, The Economic Times reported. India had already supplied two similar cranes to the port earlier this year.

VCT sets ship productivity record for a Maersk vessel

VISHAKHAPATNAM: Visakha Container Terminal (VCT) has set a new ship productivity record of 110 moves per

hour while handling the CHX service vessel Mexico, completing a total of 2113 moves in just 19.4 hours on 8 April 2021 with an average gross crane productivity of 28.8 moves per hour. The latest achievement of 110 moves per hour exceeded the terminal's earlier productivity record, achieved in December 2019, of 108 moves per hour. These achievements underscore the commitment of VCT to provide consistent and reliable best-in-class services to the shipping lines.

With the enhanced operational efficiency at the terminal, VCT is facilitating faster ship movements, thereby reducing the cost of logistics and improving the effectiveness of the supply chain for the Export Import trade. VCT's strategic location, hinterland connectivity and on-dock rail facilities are attractive to shipping lines globally.

Extending the rebates for vessel-related charges, VPT's accommodation of container vessels of 390 metre LOA and developing an empty container yard are some of the recent initiatives taken to facilitate the trade. With an additional 395-metre-long quay getting ready for operation during the third quarter of the year, terminal capacity will increase to 1.3 million TEUs annually by the end of 2021.

India plans expansion of Iran's Chabahar Port, mulls linking it with INSTC: Report

India's Shipping Minister Mansukh Mandaviya was quoted in Reuters in March that India might commence full-scale operations at the port by the end of May.

"I am expecting to visit Iran in April

or May for the inauguration of full operations,"

Chabahar port had handled 123 vessels and 1.8 million tonnes of bulk and general cargoes from February 2019 to January 2021, Mandaviya said.

The port, situated on Iran's southeastern coast along the Gulf of Oman helps India transport goods to Iran, Afghanistan, and Central Asian countries. The development of the port has been slowed by US sanctions on Iran.

CCI approves Adani Ports acquisition of 89.6% stake in Gangavaram Port

NEW DELHI: The Competition Commission of India (CCI) has approved billionaire Gautam Adani-controlled Adani Ports and Special Economic Zones Ltd's acquisition of 89.6% stake in Gangavaram Port Ltd.

Adani Ports and SEZ had earlier announced the acquisition of 58.1% stake in the port located in the northern part of Andhra Pradesh, next to Vizag Port, from D.V.S. Raju and family for Rs. 3,604 crore, winning majority control of the private port. Adani Ports had also announced the acquisition of Warburg Pincus's 31.5% stake in Gangavaram.

"The Competition Commission of India (CCI) approves acquisition of 89.6% of equity shareholding of Gangavaram Port Limited ("GPL") by Adani Ports and Special Economic Zones Limited ("APSEZ") under Section 31(1) of the Competition Act, 2002, on 13th April 2021," the corporate affairs ministry said in a statement recently.

Gangavaram Port is the second-largest non-major port in Andhra Pradesh with a 64 MMT capacity established under a concession from the State Government that extends till 2059.

"The proposed combination relates to the acquisition of 89.6% of the

shareholding in GPL (i.e., the entity operating Gangavaram port) by APSEZ," the statement said.

It is an all-weather, deep water, multipurpose port capable of handling fully laden super cape size vessels of up to 200,000 DWT. Currently, GPL operates nine berths, has freehold land of 1,800 acres and a master plan capacity for 250 MMTPA with 31 berths.

"APSEZ is an integrated port infrastructure services provider currently present across 11 domestic ports in six maritime states of Gujarat, Goa, Kerala, Andhra Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Odisha," the statement added.

India allows additional 3,675 tonnes of sugar export to UK under concessional duty quota

NEW DELHI: The Government has permitted export of an additional 3,675 tonnes of raw/refined sugar under tariff-rate quota to the United Kingdom. TRQ (Tariff-Rate Quota) is for a volume of exports that enter the UK at relatively low tariffs. After the quota is reached, a higher tariff applies to the exports.

"The additional quantity of 3,675.13

tonne of raw/refined sugar to be exported to UK under TRQ up to September 30 this year is notified," Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) said in a public notice.

It said the quota will be operated by Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEEDA) as the

implementing agency for the export.

This additional quantity of sugar is beyond the EU (European Union) CXL sugar quota of 10,000 tonnes during 2020-21 notified by the DGFT last year.

Availing the CXL concessions on export to the EU, traders can export sugar at a relatively low or zero customs duty.

India looks forward to advance talks for investment facilitation pact with EU: Piyush Goyal

NEW DELHI: India is keen to advance talks with the European Union (EU) towards an agreement on investment facilitation and protection for mutually beneficial outcome, Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal said. The Minister also emphasised on the need for proportional and simultaneous discussions on both trade and investment so that the two sides have a balanced outcome.

Further, Goyal called for an early harvest agreement and addressing non-tariff barriers between the two sides. He said this while addressing the ambassadors of the EU member states. "India looks forward to advance the negotiations towards an agreement between India and EU on investment facilitation and protection for mutually beneficial outcome," he said. He also informed that India has sent more than 65 million COVID-19 vaccines to over

80 countries around the world.

Goyal also said that India has proposed TRIPS (trade-related aspects of intellectual property rights) waiver at WTO (World Trade Organisation) for a limited period so that humanity at large could have access to the COVID-19 related products, and sought the support of the EU on the issue. EU countries collectively are the largest trading partner for India, as well as one of the largest investors.

Cochin Port Trust to construct cruise terminal at Mormugao

COCHIN: After completing the construction of a Rs 25.7 crore cruise terminal at Kochi, Cochin Port Trust has now been entrusted with the construction of the full-fledged international cruise terminal that is coming up at the harbour, said Mormugao Port Trust (MPT) Chairman E Ramesh Kumar recently.

MPT issued the work order to

Cochin Port Trust on Wednesday and the work is expected to commence shortly.

"In the backdrop of the Covid pandemic and since Cochin port has already built a cruise terminal, we have decided to appoint Cochin Port Trust as the project management consultant for this project," said Kumar. "The work order has just been issued and since

they have already executed such a project, they just need to replicate it here."

MPT has an ambitious plan to develop a domestic and international cruise terminal, which will include Ro-Ro and Ro-Pax services, which will enable cruise passengers to directly travel by smaller ferries and boats to North Goa after disembarking.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Paragraphs 2.04 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2015-2020, the Director General of Foreign Trade hereby allocates **additional quantity of 3675.13 Metric Ton** of Raw/Refined Sugar, under Tariff Rate Quota (TRQ) to UK for the year 2020-21 (upto September 30, 2021).

- As per Notification No. 3/2015-20 dated 20.04.2015, export of sugar (HS Code 17010000) to UK under TRQ is 'Free' subject to the conditions notified in the 'Nature of Restrictions' in the above notification.
- Certificate of Origin, if required, for preferential export of sugar to UK, shall be issued by Additional Director General of Foreign Trade, Mumbai. Other certification requirement, if any, prescribed specifically for export of sugar to UK would continue to be followed.
- The quota will be operated by Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA), New Delhi as the implementing agency for export of TRQ items to UK.
- The reporting requirement as notified vide Notification No. 3/2015-2020 dated 20.04.2015 read with Notification No. 20 dated 07.09.2015 would be followed.
- This additional quantity of TRQ sugar of 3675.13 MT is beyond EU CXL sugar quota of 10,000 MT during 2020-21 notified by DGFT vide Public Notice 14/2015-20 dated 21.07.2020.

7. Effect of this Public Notice:

The additional quantity of 3675.13 MT of raw/refined sugar to be exported to UK under TRQ upto 30.09.2021 is notified.

Private sector must take lead in Indo-Bhutan-Bangladesh trade through Inland Waterways, feel experts

NEW DELHI: The private sector must take the lead in Indo-Bhutan-Bangladesh trade through inland waterways in the Brahmaputra basin, said research firm CUTS International.

On Tuesday, a webinar was organised on – "Indo-Bhutan-Bangladesh Consultation on Trade and Inland Waterways Navigation in the Brahmaputra Basin" by Oxfam India (OIN) in collaboration with Oxfam Bangladesh and CUTS International.

The webinar was moderated by Bipul Chatterjee, Executive Director, CUTS International and he said that it was aimed to capture the issues of traders, understand the implications of COVID-19 on trade and inland navigation, connect the traders and the government officials and explore the spaces for women in transboundary trade through rivers.

Speaking on the occasion, Pankaj Anand, Director (Programme & Advocacy) and Oxfam too said that there are immense possibilities of trade among Bangladesh, Bhutan and India.

"The fruits of growing trade must be reaped by the most marginalized people on both sides of the border", he said during the webinar which was attended by more

than 60 participants from Bangladesh, India and Bhutan.

The organisations are working together towards income augmentation of riparian communities by promoting trade through inland waterways under the regional programme Transboundary Rivers of South Asia supported by the Swedish government.

Dr Shah Mohammad Tanvir Monsur, Bangladesh Assistant High Commissioner, Guwahati, Assam stressed that the trade basket should be enhanced and extended.

"Making trade possible and making trade happen are two different things. We need to develop the supply chain further by analysing the complementarity of the markets", he added.

Dorji Norbu, Tashi Wangmo Consultancy from Gelephu, Bhutan pointed out the need for infrastructure development at Jogighopa and Dhubri river ports in terms of dredging, clamshell cranes, steel jetty and full-fledged customs and terminal facilities. He argued for extending ports-of-calls status to Chittagong, Pyra and Mongla ports and also shared that with the development of waterways other commodities like fruits

and vegetables can also be traded with Bangladesh.

Highlighting the developmental interventions of Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI), A K Bansal, Director (Logistics & Traffic) explained the Standard Operating Procedures and protocols that IWAI was developing with their counterparts across the border to make inland waterways easier to navigate and trade upon.

"Industry should take advantage of waterways and shift a share of the cargo to inland waterways," he added.

Inland waterways have provided a safe means of transport during COVID-19 even other modes of transport could not be used due to border closure.

Sharmila Khanam, Deputy Director, Bangladesh Inland Water Transport Authority explained the initiations and plans of the authority and how trade via waterways sustained even during COVID.

In her concluding remarks Vinuthna Patibandla, Programme Officer, Oxfam said that Oxfam and CUTS will take forward the concerns expressed by the traders to the competent authorities in Bangladesh, Bhutan and India.

Indonesia emerges largest buyer of India sugar in first quarter of 2021, says AISTA

NEW DELHI: All India Sugar Traders Association (AISTA) has claimed that India has dispatched 55% of the sugar export quota announced by the Union government under the Maximum Admissible Export Quota (MAEQ) 2020-21 scheme. So far, during the first three months since the scheme became applicable, Indonesia has emerged as the top importer of Indian sugar accounting for 38% share of the total sugar dispatched.

Indian government had announced a scheme in January 2021 to incentivise

exports and thus reduce the surplus sugar in the domestic market. The scheme was meant to help the sugarcane growing farmers as it assumed that the sugar mills will pay their bills on time when the sugar prices in the domestic market improve on clearing the excess stocks. However, the arrears of sugarcane farmers continue to rule high in the top two sugar producing states of Uttar Pradesh and Maharashtra.

According to AISTA, as on April 9, India has moved 15 lakh tonnes of raw sugar, 9.5 lakh tonnes of white sugar and

37,000 tonnes of refined sugar; with the total sugar stock in transit and delivered to port based refinery accounting for about 28 lakh tonnes. Sugar that is under loading for export or nominated for export is little over 5 lakh tonnes.

The top 6 export destinations for India sugar till April are Indonesia (38.5%), Afghanistan (12.3%), Sri Lanka (9.9%), UAE (9%), Somalia (7.6%) and Bangladesh (5.6%). Quoting market sources, AISTA press note has said that the country has contracted for export of 49 lakh tonnes of sugar.

Truck rentals plunge, hit by new Covid-19 wave

NEW DELHI: Truck leases have plunged past expectation within the first fortnight of April, prompted by a surge in Covid-19's new wave that has led to a decline within the arrival of meals and vegetable objects on the mandis (Agriculture Produce Market Committees or APMC), based on the Indian Basis of Transport Analysis and Coaching (IFTRT), a transport sector suppose tank.

APMCs had been arrange by the State governments to make sure good worth discovery for farmers and to stop retailers from having an undue bargaining benefit.

Covid-19's new wave within the final fortnight has led to a decline in arrival of meals and vegetable objects on the APMCs, with a 10-15 per cent drop in demand from eating places and accommodations, mentioned IFTRT's Senior Fellow S.P. Singh.

Dispatches from manufacturing facility gates, too, dropped decrease by an identical 10-15 per cent.

The worst hit was manufacturing in Micro Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME), though diesel and tyre costs (two principal variables working bills) have remained unchanged over the earlier fortnight of March 2021).

Rentals Drop

Consequently, truck leases on trunk routes plunged past expectation for spherical journeys on an 18-20 tonne payload between April 1 and April 14, mentioned IFTRT.

Rental fees on the Delhi-Mumbai-Delhi route dropped 16 per cent on April 14 in opposition to April 1 (from Rs 1.35 lakh to Rs 1.15 lakh), the 2 large metros within the North and West. Each the cities face a pointy surge in Covid-19 instances.

Additionally, leases on the Delhi-Nagpur-Delhi route have plunged by 10 per cent (from Rs 1.07 lakh to Rs 96,800), the analysis physique mentioned referring to Nagpur, the central level of the nation that has quite a lot of warehouses given the placement.

Equally, charges on the Delhi-Ranchi-Delhi sector have plunged 15 per cent (from Rs 1.17 lakh to Rs 1 lakh), with the Japanese metropolis going through a pointy surge in Covid-19.

Charges on the Delhi-Chennai-Delhi sector are down 13 per cent (from Rs 1.55 lakh to Rs 1.35 lakh), whereas truck leases on the Delhi-Kandla-Delhi route have dropped by 15 per cent (from Rs 1.02 lakh to Rs 86,000).

Total, on 75 medium and lengthy haulage truck routes tracked by IFTRT, trucking enterprise has confronted a sudden hunch after bouncing final month, attributable to fears of a "direct or backdoor lockdown" throughout the nation.

Fleet utilisation down, drivers head residence

Fleet utilisation is all the way down to 60 per cent and given the rising development of truck drivers making ready to return to their residence cities or villages to flee the brand new wave of coronavirus, the state of affairs for commerce, commerce and business is grim, resulting in panic within the transport enterprise.

That mentioned, the Authorities has contracted out its bit by extending the fee of highway tax or allow payment by three extra months as much as June 30, 2021. Additionally, for the second consecutive 12 months, the annual hike in insurance coverage fees (with impact from April yearly) have been prevented on the orders of the regulator, which has come as a reduction for fleet homeowners. But when the state of affairs stays boring, truckers could default in paying their equal month-to-month instalments (EMI) for truck buy. Additionally, truck unions could demand yet one more moratorium, predicted IFTRT's Singh.

Hapag-Lloyd orders 150,000 TEU of standard and Reefer Containers for 2021



H A M B U R G : Hapag-Lloyd is stepping up once more the investment in its

container fleet in light of the current situation – similar to what the container shipping line did in 2020 in its initial response to the pandemic – as today it needs significantly more than the normal number of boxes to carry the same volume because boxes are turning slower.

The container shipping line has ordered 150,000 TEU from China – both dry boxes and state-of-the-art reefer containers. Some of the boxes were already delivered to Hapag-Lloyd and integrated into its existing container fleet in the first quarter for 2021, but the majority of them are expected to be delivered in the upcoming months. Additionally, Hapag-Lloyd has ordered 8,000 TEU of special containers to be used for over-sized or dangerous goods.

The investments amount to roughly USD 550 million – making it one of the biggest container orders in the history of Hapag-Lloyd.
